#### 16.20-17.20 WORKSHOP: "Traffic Analysis in Cyberspace"

Traffic Analysis (TA) can be used to circumvent many security schemes. TA leverages metadata and network flow data related to the source, destination, size, frequency, and direction of information, from which eavesdroppers can deduce a comprehensive analysis of human communications. TA is effective in economic, political, intelligence, and military affairs. Today, modern information technology and the interconnected nature of cyberspace have made TA a global and universally accessible discipline – and a global concern. Digital metadata, affordable computer storage, and automated information processing now record and analyze nearly all human activities. This talk examines the history of TA and employs TA against a large cybersecurity dataset.
